are on the sinful kingdom.

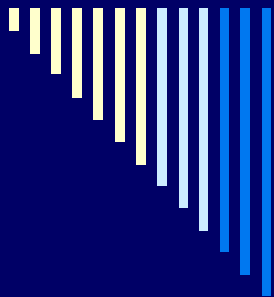
I will destroy it

David's fallen tent.

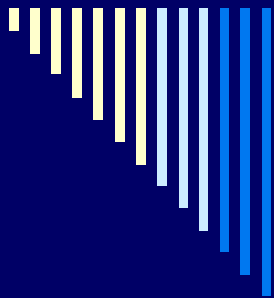
I will repair its broken places,

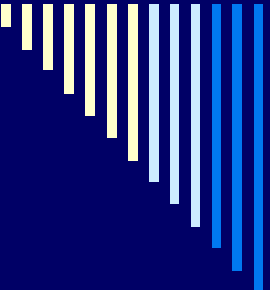
- ❑ Order

Kingdom Order

1 Chron. 15:1-2 (NIV)

After David had constructed buildings for himself in the City of David, he prepared a place for the ark of God and pitched a tent for it. [2] Then David said, "No one but the Levites may carry the ark of God, because the Lord chose them to carry the ark of the Lord and to minister before him forever."

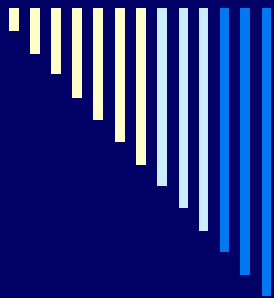


1 Chron. 15:11-14 (KJV)

And David called for Zadok and Abiathar the priests, and for the Levites, for Uriel, Asaiah, and Joel, Shemaiah, and Eliel, and Amminadab, 1 Chron. 15:12 (KJV)

And said unto them, Ye are the chief of the fathers of the Levites: sanctify yourselves, both ye and your brethren, that ye may bring up the ark of the Lord God of Israel unto the place that I have prepared for it. For because ye did it not at the first, the Lord our God made a breach upon us, for that we sought him not after the due order.

[14] So the priests and the Levites sanctified themselves to bring up the ark of the Lord God of Israel.



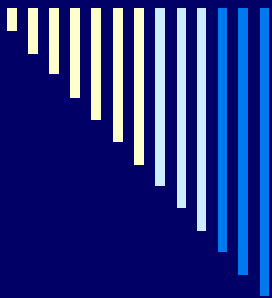
Pure Worship

1 Chron. 15:16 (NIV)

David told the leaders of the Levites to appoint their brothers as singers to sing joyful songs, accompanied by musical instruments: lyres, harps and cymbals.

1 Chron. 15:22 (NKJV)

Chenaniah, leader of the Levites, was instructor in charge of the music, because he was skillful;



1 Chron. 15:29 (NIV)

As the ark of the covenant of the Lord was entering the City of David, Michal daughter of Saul watched from a window. And when she saw King David dancing and celebrating, she despised him in her heart.

- *She mistook his holy zeal for exhibitionism*

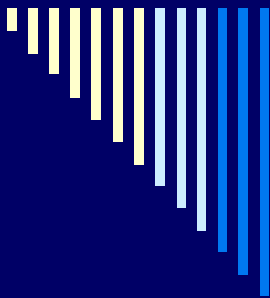
Bible Knowledge Commentary



To Make a Difference: Sinners/Saints

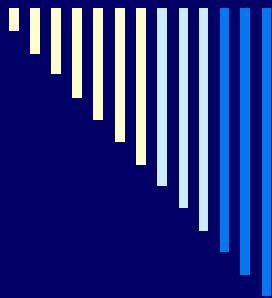
2 Samuel 6:20 (NASB)

But when David returned to bless his household, Michal the daughter of Saul came out to meet David and said, "How the king of Israel distinguished himself today! He uncovered himself today in the eyes of his servants' maids as one of the foolish ones shamelessly uncovers himself!"



2 Samuel 6:21-23 (NASB)

So David said to Michal, "It was before the Lord, who chose me above your father and above all his house, to appoint me ruler over the people of the Lord, over Israel; therefore I will celebrate before the Lord. [22] "And I will be more lightly esteemed than this and will be humble in my own eyes, but with the maids of whom you have spoken, with them I will be distinguished." [23] And Michal the daughter of Saul had no child to the day of her death.



A Holy People

1 Chron. 16:1-3 (NIV)

They brought the ark of God and set it inside the tent that David had pitched for it, and they presented burnt offerings and fellowship offerings before God. [2] After David had finished sacrificing the burnt offerings and fellowship offerings, he blessed the people in the name of the Lord. [3] Then he gave a loaf of bread, a cake of dates and a cake of raisins to each Israelite man and woman.



House Among the Nations

Amos 9:12 (KJV)

That they (*the Nations*) may possess the remnant of Edom, and of all the heathen, which are called by my name, saith the Lord that doeth this.



Amos, Peter, & James

Acts 15:6-8 (KJV)

And the apostles and elders came together for to consider of this matter. [7] And when there had been much disputing, Peter rose up, and said unto them, Men and brethren, ye know how that a good while ago God made choice among us, that the Gentiles by my mouth should hear the word of the gospel, and believe. [8] And God, which knoweth the hearts, bare them witness, giving them the Holy Ghost, even as he did unto us;

Acts 15:13-19 (NASB)

And after they had stopped speaking, James answered, saying, "Brethren, listen to me. [14] "Simeon has related how God first concerned Himself about taking from among the Gentiles a people for His name. [15] "And with this the words of the Prophets agree, just as it is written,

[16] 'After these things I will return,

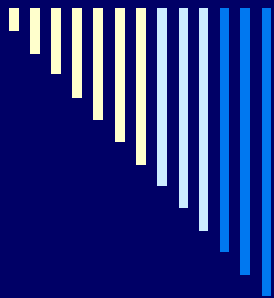
And I will rebuild the TABERNACLE OF David which has fallen,

[17] In order that the rest of MANKIND MAY SEEK THE Lord,
