“The One True God”

Isaiah 41:4 (KJV)

Who hath wrought and done it, calling the generations from the beginning? I the Lord, the first, and with the last; I am he.

Rev. 1:1 (KJV)

The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God (*God the Father*) gave unto him, to shew unto his servants things which must shortly come to pass; and he sent and signified it by his angel unto his servant John:

The Eternally Omnipotent One

Rev. 1:4-6 (KJV)

John to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace be unto you, and peace, from him which is, and which was, and which is to come (*God the Father*); and from the seven Spirits (*Holy Spirit*) which are before his throne; [5] And from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, and the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood, [6] And hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

Commander of Hosts

Rev. 1:7-8 (KJV)

Behold, he cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see him, and they also which pierced him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen.
[8] I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the *Lord*, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty (*El Shaddai*, "*Jehovah Sabaoth*," that is, "of hosts").

Lord – many manuscripts instead of "Lord" Kurios, read Theos (God), now considered the correct reading. (See Barnes Notes)

Jehovah the “Word”

John 1:1-2 (NIV)

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. [2] He was with God in the beginning.

Father Says to Son

Psalm 110:1-6 (NIV)

Of David. A psalm.

The Lord says to my Lord: "Sit at my right hand until I make your enemies a footstool for your feet."

[2] The Lord will extend your mighty scepter from Zion; you will rule in the midst of your enemies.

[3] Your troops will be willing on your day of battle.

Arrayed in holy majesty, from the womb of the dawn

you will receive the dew of your youth. [4] The Lord has sworn and will not change his mind:

Warrior God

1 Cor. 15:22-25 (NIV)

For as in Adam all die, so in Christ all will be made alive. [23] But each in his own turn: Christ, the firstfruits; then, when he comes, those who belong to him. [24] Then the end will come, when he hands over the kingdom to God the Father after he has destroyed all dominion, authority and power. [25] For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet.

The Revelation

Rev. 1:10-16 (NIV)

On the Lord's Day I was in the Spirit, and I heard behind me a loud voice like a trumpet, [11] which said: "Write on a scroll what you see and send it to the seven churches: to Ephesus, Smyrna, Pergamum, Thyatira, Sardis, Philadelphia and Laodicea." [12] I turned around to see the voice that was speaking to me. And when I turned I saw seven golden lampstands, [13] and among the lampstands was someone "like a son of man," dressed in a robe reaching down to his feet and with a golden sash around his chest. [14] His head and hair were white like wool, as white as snow, and his eyes were like blazing fire. [15] His feet were like bronze glowing in a furnace, and his voice was like the sound of rushing waters. [16] In his right hand he held seven stars, and out of his mouth came a sharp double-edged sword. His face was like the sun shining in all its brilliance.

Image of the Invisible God

Rev. 1:17-18 (NIV)

When I saw him, I fell at his feet as though dead. Then he placed his right hand on me and said: "Do not be afraid. I am the First and the Last. [18] I am the Living One; I was dead, and behold I am alive for ever and ever! And I hold the keys of death and Hades.

Jesus “Is” God

Hebrews 1:6-9 (NIV)

And again, when God brings his firstborn into the world, he says, "Let all God's angels worship him." [7] In speaking of the angels he says, "He makes his angels winds, his servants flames of fire."

[8] But about the Son he says, "Your throne, O God, will last for ever and ever, and righteousness will be the scepter of your kingdom. [9] You have loved righteousness and hated wickedness; therefore God, your God, has set you above your companions by anointing you with the oil of joy."

Save Them from My Wrath

John 3:33-36 (NIV)

The man who has accepted it has certified that God is truthful. [34] For the one whom God has sent speaks the words of God, for God gives the Spirit without limit. [35] The Father loves the Son and has placed everything in his hands. [36] Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on him."

Father's Work of Reconciliation

1 Tim. 2:3-6 (NIV)

This is good, and pleases God our Savior, [4] who wants all men to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth. [5] For there is one God and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, [6] who gave himself as a ransom for all men--the testimony given in its proper time.

The Father is Working

2 Cor. 5:18-19 (NIV)

All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: [19] that God (*The Father*) was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation.
